Touton has been a major player in the global cocoa trade for decades. In addition to sourcing cocoa beans and cocoa derivatives, Touton now also processes cocoa liquour in Ghana.

Over the years, Touton has invested in facilities for the collection and export of cocoa in Africa's top cocoa producing countries: Côte d'Ivoire, Ghana, Nigeria, and Cameroon. Our coffee department has significantly increased over the years. We source green beans from fifteen Robusta and Arabica origins supplied directly from the producing regions of Asia, Africa and Latin America. Spice and ingredients trade played a major role in the development of Touton's activities since the mid 19th Century. Touton offers a variety of spices and natural ingredients, from cinnamon to cloves, annato seeds, pepper, sesame seeds, ginger and bees' wax. Most of our ingredients are sourced in Africa while others are sourced in Indonesia and Vietnam.



Touton started trading vanilla in the late 19th century. Nowadays, it remains a major player in the natural vanilla market, buying vanilla wholesale, exporting vanilla and linking vanilla producers with vanilla processors. Touton vanilla is sold to customers in the aromatic and perfume industry, as well as the foodprocessing sector.
